Letter 16 - Letter dated October 20, 2003, to James R. Lett from Barbara K. Oates, Account Monitoring Unit, Internal Auditing Division, West Virginia Department of Tax and Revenue, authoring the release of final payment to R & R Pipeline, Inc. for the I-77 Rest Area Sewer Extension Project.

Letter 71 - Letter dated November 13, 2003, to Margaret Batten from Sara Boardman, Accountant, West Virginia Municipal Bond Commission, listing the list of new accounts that the District must fund beginning December 1, 2004, for the MWPSD 03-A Sewer Revenue Bonds.

Letter 93 - Copy of letter dated November 19, 2003, to Richard Boice from R. Shayne Brabham enclosing a copy of the Option Agreement for a water tank site on Limestone Ridge between the District and Mr. Boice.

Mr. Brabham gave his monthly operations report. He discussed the following items:

1. The Department of Highways will be responsible for all testing required by the Department of Environmental Protection as stated in the District's WV NPDES

Permit for the newly installed Lift Station at the I-77 Rest Area. The State will have the testing done at its cost and will send the results to the District to be included in its monthly DMR Reports.

- 2. The Dover Drive Sewer Replacement Project is progressing. Mr. Brabham said that the contractor has sawed the asphalt and that the manhole has been delivered. He also reported that the contractor, Speciality Piping Corporation, will not work during the week of Thanksgiving.
- 3. The Option Agreement for the water tank site on Limestone Ridge has been signed. Mr. and Mrs. Boice agreed to the terms of the latest option agreement and signed the document. Cerrone Associates will begin surveying the site the last week of November. Virginia McDonald, Rural Utilities Service, said that she can have the grant and loan papers processed through her office within thirty days once she receives the title opinions, bond issues and other necessary documents from the District's attorney.
- 4. Mr. Brabham stated that he has contacted several vendors about purchasing a pipe line inspection camera. Due to the complexity of the different models offered, he said that it may be necessary for him to take some field trips to look at the various models before deciding which one to purchase.

At the conclusion of Mr. Brabham's report, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 6:10 p.m.
