Mr. Brabham reported on several items that the District is working on. He had been informed that the core drilling would take place on the Boice Tank Site before the Project goes to bid. Specialty Piping is making progress on the 215 Dover Sewer repair. They hope to be finished in approximately two weeks. Specialty Piping has gone over budget and will be needing more money. Department of Environmental Protection said they will review the budget before authorizing additional money for the by-pass road that Specialty Piping built for the residents on Dover Drive. Cerrone Associates, Inc., did not approve a by-pass road to be constructed.

Mr. Bosley - owner of Oakes Trailer Park - has been working on the corrections that needed to be made for the run-off going into the District's sewer system.

All business having been completed, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 6:30 p.m.
