Mr. Brabham reported there is a PSC Board Member Seminar in Parkersburg Holiday Inn on February 26, 27, and 28th if any of the Board Members wants to attend.

Dover Drive / Dechlorination Project is moving right along. The 10" main line has been installed. Two service reconnects are left. Clean up and concrete work will begin next week. Plant work will start February 22, 2004.

When the Wilson/Lemon 2" Water Line was being installed, the contractor cut Mr. Wilcox's service line three different times and his gas service once. The repairs were made and the contractor said that he would warrant the repairs for one year. Joe Brown contacted Mr. Hardman stating that Mr. Wilcox wanted a free tap on the new 2" line so he wouldn't have to worry about the repaired service line. He was told up front that if he wanted to hook to the new line, he would have to pay actual cost of the entire installation of the new service. Mr. Wilson and Mr. Lemon were charged for the fittings required to repair Wilcox's service line during the installation. Mrs. Lemon contacted the PSC.

The Water Buffalo has dispensed 1,062,800 gallons of water as of July 1, 2003.

All business having been completed, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 6:30 p.m.
