Mrs. Batten presented the Board with Change Order No. 1 to Contract 2A-Stonegate Construction Company. The amount of Change Order No. 1 to Contract 2A is \$12,000.00. The Change Order is to upgrade line 23 from 2" to 6" pipe. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve Change Order No. 1 to Contract 2A - Stonegate Construction Company. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Stewart signed Change Order No. 1 to Contract 2A-Stonegate Construction Company.

There was a discussion concerning the removal of outdated sewer lab chemicals, obsolete chlorine regulator parts, etc., from the inventory. The total cost of these items is \$2,030.00. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to remove these items from inventory. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mrs. Batten discussed Letter 87 the District received from Rosaline Brodersen, Program Manager, State Revolving Fund Program, West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, stating that the eighth loan reimbursement request in the amount of \$74,786.00 for the District's Dover Drive/Wastewater Treatment Plant Dechlorination Project has been approved. Ms. Brodersen recommends that the balance of the SRF loan be drawn on the next payment under the Reserve Fund line item and deposited in the District's account withe the Municipal Bond Commission. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion for the District to follow Ms. Brodersen's advice. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Letter 97 - Letter dated July 9, 2004, to Charles Stewart from George E. Blumm, Director, Finance & Administration, Cerrone Associates, Inc., enclosing for review and approval six copies of Change Order No. 1 to Contract 2A (Stonegate Construction, Inc.).

This concluded Mrs. Batten's report.

Mr. Brabham reported that the project is moving right along. The West Virginia Department of Highways is being reluctant to let the District tie-in the water line at their West Virginia Rest Area. This is creating somewhat of a problem, but hopefully it can be worked around.
