Customer 2202-2 wants 2" main extended to property line approximately 1700'. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to extend 2" main to customers property line. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

WV will not pay for betterment on line relocation for the new Slate Creek Bridge project. The District will have to pay for the upgrade from a 2" to 6". The cost of this upgrade would be approximately \$14, 000.00.
