Letter 101 - Fax dated November 17, 2004, to Shayne Brabham from Manning Frymier, P. E., Cerrone Associates, Inc., enclosing a corrected quote from Miller Communications for the Limestone Booster to Windy Tank telemetry link.

Mrs. Batten informed the Board that the District has begun making payments to Municipal Bond. The first payment was made on November 15, 2004. This is for the Dechlorination/ Dover Drive project.

This concluded Mrs. Batten's report.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that each employee receive a one time pay increase of \$125.00 gross with the December 15<sup>th</sup> payroll. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that effective January 1, 2005 each employee receive a thirty-five cent (.35) on the hour pay raise. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Brabham reported on the progress of the water extension project.

Contract 1 is near completion. The 2" line is being installed on Dove Creek and Stephens Fork. Once these lines are in place, the I-77 crossing can be made.

Contract 2A has approximately 5000' to be installed. This is do to rock skips and gas line crossings. The footers for the Dent Booster Station were poured on Wednesday, November 17, 2004. The building should be set the following week.

Contract 2B has all the main line installed. A few road bores and service taps remain to be completed.

Contract 3 (Windy Ridge Water Storage Tank) has been completed and waiting on water before disinfection can be done. Once water is available, both contractors plan to test/disinfect through winter.

The District wrote a letter to Katy Mallory, Infrastructure Council, giving her a project update and requesting the use of remaining funds to purchase radio read water meter units and to have our water storage tanks painted.

The District submitted time sheets and invoices to FEMA for reimbursement for the expenses incurred from hurricane Ivan.

Mr. Brabham made a request for a 6 x 12 utility trailer to be purchased for the District to use to haul several items at a time. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion authorizing Mr. Brabham to purchase for

the District a 6 x 12 utility trailer 3000 lb axle for approximately \$875.00. The cost may vary somewhat, but it should be less than \$1000.00. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

All business having been discussed, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 7:05 p.m.
