Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve the Financial Statement dated May 31, 2005, for All Finances Revenue Fund (copy attached). Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve the Financial Statement dated May 31, 2005, for Water Revenue Fund Checking Account (copy attached). Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve check number 31129 thru 31130 written on the Sewer Revenue Checking Account and check number 35000 thru 35074 written on the Consolidated-Sewer Revenue Checking Account between May 20, 2005 - June 15, 2005 (copy attached). Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve check number 35080 thru 35086 written June 16, 2005, on the Consolidated-Sewer Revenue Checking Account (copy attached). Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve Payroll check number 1510 thru 1525 written on the Consolidated Payroll Account between May 20, 2005-June 16, 2005 (copy attached). Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mrs. Batten presented the following letters for discussion.

Letter 45 - Letter dated May 27, 2005, to Charles Stewart from Virginia Mc Donald, Rural Development Specialist, Rural Utilities Service, stating that funds in the amount of \$19,000.00 will be deposited into the Stephens Fork Water Construction Account at WesBanco Bank, Inc. on June 1, 2005. The District is authorized to use these funds to pay the first year's interest on Loan No. 91-09. It also states that monthly principal and interest payments in the amount of \$3,518.00 will begin on July 17, 2005.

Letter 77 - Fax dated June 8, 2005, from Claywood Park Public Service District announcing the retirement of Jack Beck and inviting everyone to a lunch being held in his honor on June 30, 2005, starting at 12 noon at the Claywood Office.

Letter 80 - Letter dated June 8, 2005, to Margaret Batten from Dale Meadows, Permit Supervisor, West Virginia Division of Highways, reducing the District's Construction Bond on Permit 3-04-243 for the Sycamore Run, Stephens Fork, Limestone Ridge Water Extension Project from \$100,000.00 to \$10,000.00. This letter was also received by fax on June 8, 2005.

Letter 90 - Memorandum dated June 9, 2005, to Benefits Coordinator from Joe Estep, Premium Accounts Supervisor, West Virginia Public Employees Insurance Agency, stating that all groups expect Non State Agencies will remain under the 2005 Rate Structure until at lease December 31, 2005. Non State Agencies will be under the 2006 Rate Structure beginning July 1, 2005.

District, from Margaret Batten, Office Manager, rendering her resignation due to retirement effective on August 31, 2005. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to accept Mrs. Batten's letter of resignation as presented with great reluctance because of her great job performance throughout the 34 years of service. Her job performance has been quite exemplary over the years. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that Mrs. Church who is now Assistant Office Manager be promoted to Office Manager with a pay increase at the time Mrs. Batten retires. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that an ad be placed in the Parkersburg News and Sentinel to run from Friday thru Sunday July 1, 2005 - July 3, 2005, for an Office Clerk with applications being accepted until the close of business on July 11, 2005. Applications will be scanned by Mrs. Batten and Mrs. Church and hopefully have a potential applicant or applicants to be interviewed by the July 21st Board Meeting. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mrs. Batten brought it to the Boards attention that it was time to discuss the pay raise they usually give the employees. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that each employee receive a .35 cent per hour effective July 1, 2005. Mr. Metz is to receive the .35 cents now and he will receive his \$1.00 per hour increase, if his work is satisfactory, at the end of his probation period. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mrs. Batten reported that the Special Meeting for July will need to be July 12, 2005 instead of July 14, 2005.

Mr. Hanna reported on various items that the District has been involved in.

Mr. Bartley has moved the water line that was in the middle of Mr. Hogsett's driveway.

The feed and seeding has been completed at the Sams Creek Church water and sewer line relocation area that had to be done because of the mud slide.

There has been no new development at this time concerning the trailer court that was being discussed in the Oakbook area.

Mr. Hanna spoke with the District's engineer concerning the firm that was interested in developing the area above the Woodridge Golf Course. It would require a tank and booster equipment to supply water to that area.

The District's insurance company paid for new carpet at the Lewis Wheaton residence. Our sewer

had backed up into their basement. We should be reimbursed for the \$1,300.00 that we paid for having the carpet cleaned.

The relocation of the Districts water and sewer lines has been completed by the Department of Highways.

Browns Ridge water line has been pressure tested and chlorinated. Providence Road water line test failed, but has been re-flushed and retested and the District is waiting on the results.

The last item to report on is the acquiring of a right-of-way from the Victory Assembly of God. It will let the District get into a grinder pump that has to be pumped and repaired quite often. The legal work has been started on acquiring this right-of-way.

All business having been discussed, Mr. Lett made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Radabaugh seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 6:50 p.m.
