MINUTES OF A REGULAR MONTHLY BOARD MEETING OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD OF THE MINERAL WELLS PUBLIC SERVICE DISTRICT HELD THURSDAY, MARCH 16, 2006, AT 5:00 P.M. IN THE DISTRICT'S OFFICE LOCATED AT MINERAL WELLS, WEST VIRGINIA

Mr. Charles Stewart, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. He asked everyone present to sign the attendance roster. Roy L. Radabaugh, Treasurer; James R. Lett, Secretary; Russell Hanna, Operation Manager; Linda K. Church, Office Manager; Nellie Radcliff, Office Clerk; Brian Metz, Operations Technician; R. Shayne Brabham, Claywood Public Service District, Assistant General Manager and Todd Grinstead, Claywood Public Service District, General Manager were present.

The first order of business was the discussion of the financing of the Claywood Park Public Service District Water Plant upgrade project. Mr. Grinstead presented the Board with figures of a tentative Budget for the new upgrade. The original Budget (2002) total project cost was \$5,295,000.00. Revised Budget after bids was \$7,858,000.00. Revised Budget as of March 2006 is \$6,503,975.00. The Public Service Commission approved Mineral Wells Public Service District's share to be \$256,935.00 per year. While the meeting was in progress, Mr. George Blum, Cerrone Associates, Inc., called and informed Mr. Grinstead that the anticipated share for Mineral Wells Public Service District would be increased to approximately \$280,000.00 an increase of \$12,000.00 per year or 5%. Mr. Grinstead informed the Board that they have trimmed everything from the project they can possibly trim to get the project down to bid proposal. They were able to trim \$1,308,975.00, but after this figure the cost is still over budget. They have been in contact with the Public Service Commission and are exploring every avenue possible to receive financing for the project. They will keep Mineral Wells Public Service Board members informed of any progress they make in obtaining financing.

Mr. Grinstead informed the Board that the construction company that was low bidder will hold the bid until the end of June 2006 providing there is no big increase in the price of construction materials. He is hoping to have an order from the Public Service Commission stating that the project can break ground by then. If they have to re-bid, it will most probably come in at a much higher bid.

Mr. Brabham discussed with the Board a problem that occurred with Mr. Phil Lemley and Stonegate Construction Co. while he was still employed with Mineral Wells Public Service District. It seems that Stonegate Construction Company caused a gas leak at the Lemley residence and refused to repair it. The neighbors that are on the private gas line repaired the leak and sent Stonegate Construction Co. a bill in an amount of approximately \$638.00. As of today's date, March 16, 2006, Stonegate Construction Co., has failed to pay this bill. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the District pay this bill to Mr. Lemley and seek reimbursement from Stonegate Construction Co. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Grinstead and Mr. Brabham excused themselves from the rest of the meeting.

Mr. Brian Metz was present to address the board. He thanked them for giving him the opportunity to go to school and further his education in the course of Water Treatment Class and Wastewater Management. He excused himself from the rest of the meeting.

Mr. Lett made a motion to approve the Minutes of the February 16, 2006, Regular Board Meeting as presented. Mr. Radabaugh seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Lett signed the Minutes.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve the Financial Statement dated February 28, 2006, for All Finances (copy attached). Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve the Financial Statement dated February 28, 2006, for Water Revenue Fund Checking Account (copy attached). Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve the Financial Statement dated February 28, 2006, for Sewer Revenue Fund Checking Account (copy attached). Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve checks numbered 35860 thru 35955 written on the Consolidated-Water and Sewer Revenue Checking Account (copy attached) between February 17, 2006 and March 16, 2006. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve payroll checks numbered 1659 thru 1674 written on the Consolidate Payroll Account (copy attached). Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mrs. Church reviewed the following letters.

Mr. Hanna expressed that he wanted to attend this seminar. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion authorizing Mr. Hanna to attend this seminar. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Letter 60 - Copy of letter dated March 13, 2006, to Virginia McDonald, USDA-Rural Development Rural Utilities Service, cc Russ Hanna from Manning Frymier, P.E., Cerrone Associates following up Ms. McDonald's letter dated January 12, 2006 denying approval to use remaining contingency monies to tank painting. The District's stand on the issue is that all customers of the District are contributing to pay for this project through rate increases.

Letter 62 - Copy of letter dated March 10, 2006, to Brian W. Metz from Dawn Newell, HHR Program Manager I, State of WV Department of Health and Human Resources Bureau for Public Health Office of Environmental Health Services informing Mr. Metz of his passing grade on the Class 1 public water supply operator exam.

Letter 65 - Notice received March 16, 2006, dated March 8, 2006 from American Flow Control issuing an important Safety Notice alerting customers and distributors that the hydrant operating rods and grease in model B-84-B,B-62-B,B-50-B and MK73 hydrants with cast dates from 1999 thru 2003 must be replaced. AFC will provide, at no cost, operation rod replacement kits, installations instructions, parts necessary to replace and labor allowance of \$40.00 for each hydrant repaired.

Mrs. Church reported to the Board that forms need to be signed to change the regular checking account to an interest bearing account. Also, in order to get a new visa card for the District, the old account will need to be closed and a new account opened. Mr. Radabaugh agreed to go the bank

and see if he could get a new card for the District.

Mrs. Church reported that the District has installed four(4) grinder pumps since the last deposit was made into the grinder pump reserve account. She stated that a deposit of \$2,000.00 should be made into the account as soon as the District has funds available. The Board agreed to wait until a later date to make a deposit into this account. This concluded Mrs. Church's report.

Mr. Hanna reported on the following items.

Mr. Frymier, P.E. Cerrone Associates, Inc., is still trying to obtain the funds to paint the storage tanks thru the contingency funds from the Sycamore Run, Stephens Fork, Limestone Water Extension Project. He, also, sent a fax with the cost of re-locating the water line on Slate Creek Road. The line is in a road slip and needs to be moved. The estimated cost of this is \$32,000.00.

The Board discussed the above items and there may need to be a rate hike to cover the cost of these two items. No motion was made concerning the items.

Mr. Hanna has been in contact with the City of Parkersburg concerning the emergency connection of the water lines of the District to the City's water line. The City is willing to share the cost. As of today's date there have been no numbers as to the cost discussed.

Mr. Hanna reported nothing has been accomplished in two and a half weeks at the Wastewater Treatment Plant in reference to the sludge removal. IVS Hydro lost a bag in the pond, bag split and water is not draining as it was suppose to, now they need to add lime to the bags that have drained.

Mr. Hanna discussed with the Board the rate of pay increase that the maintenance men receive when they go to school for a certificate. The rule now says the men have to accumulate 2000 hours of on the job training after they pass the test to earn the certificate to receive a pay increase of fifty cents per hour per certificate. They would like to have this changed so that when they pass the test they could receive twenty-five cents per hour pay increase and receive the other twenty-five cents when they receive the certificate. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to increase the pay scale by twenty-five cents per hour at the time the test is passed and increase the pay scale by another twenty-five cents per hour at the time the certificate is earned. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The fence has been installed around the Bogal Ridge Water Tank.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion authorizing Mr. Hanna to discuss with Mr. Lowther concerning the District paying half the cost of installing a fence around the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

All business having been discussed, Mr. Lett made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Radabaugh seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 7:00 p.m.
