Holiday Inn Express is planning a hotel on Nicholette Road, Curtain at the lagoon has been repaired, lagoon is being filled, Chlorine tank has been cleaned, Slate Creek Bridge is completed enough that a tie-in is scheduled for Monday, September 25, 2006, Leigh Mason Trailer Park is still not ready to go, the solar panel for the telemetry has been out, but is now working properly. This concluded Mr. Byers' report.

Mr. Radabaugh requested that the Board go into an executive session with Ms. Dyer. Mr. Stewart recessed the regular meeting at 6:20 p.m.
