MINUTES OF A REGULAR MONTHLY BOARD MEETING OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD OF THE MINERAL WELLS PUBLIC SERVICE DISTRICT HELD THURSDAY, MARCH 19, 2009, AT 5:00 P.M. IN THE DISTRICT'S OFFICE LOCATED AT MINERAL WELLS, WEST VIRGINIA

Mr. Radabaugh, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. He asked everyone present to sign the attendance roster. James R. Lett, Secretary; Charles M. Stewart, Treasurer; Todd Anderson, Operations Manager; Cathy Dyer, Office Manager; Linda Watson and Nellie Radcliff, Office Clerks; William Byers, Operations Tech.; Howard Baldwin, resident was present.

There was no one present from the public with any comments.

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The first order of business was the reading and approving of the Minutes of the February 19, 2009, Board meeting. Mr. Lett made a motion that the Minutes be approved as presented. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Lett signed the Minutes of February 19, 2009, Board Meeting.

Kay Hill was not present to discuss the Butcher Bend Lagoon Maintenance Association.

Mrs. Dyer presented the Board with an agreement between the West Virginia Department of Highways for the Barnett Bridge Project. Mr. Lett made a motion to accept the agreement as presented. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Radabaugh signed the Agreement.

Mr. Anderson and Mrs. Dyer presented information regarding the Northern Jackson PSD buying the lines that are in their area in Jackson Co. George Blum, Cerrone Association, Inc., worked up a cost of the debt service and according to his calculation the cost that Northern Jackson would pay the Mineral Wells PSD should be approximately \$35,158.00. An Agreement of Understanding will need to be compiled.

Mr. Anderson presented the Board with the proposals that the District had received for mowing the Lift Stations, Waste Water Treatment Plant and Tank Sites (copy attached). The quotes were so high that Mr. Anderson recommended that the Maintenance men mow the Tank sites, Lift Stations and hire the Waste Water Treatment Plant site out to the lowest bidder that submitted a quote. Mr. Lett made a motion to reject the bids as presented and that Mr. Anderson contact the lowest bidder for the Wastewater Treatment Plant site. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Lett made a motion to approve the Financial Statement dated February 28, 2009 for All Finances (copy attached). Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Lett made a motion to approve the Financial Statement dated February 28, 2009, for Water Revenue Checking Account (copy attached). Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Lett made a motion to approve the Financial Statement dated February 28, 2009, for Sewer Revenue Checking Account (copy attached). Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Lett made a motion to approve checks 039521 thru 039610 written on the Consolidate Water and Sewer Revenue Checking Account between February 20, 2009 and March 19, 2009, (copy attached). Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Lett made a motion to approve Payroll Checks 2280 thru 2311 written on the Consolidate Payroll Account between February 20, 2009 and March 19, 2009, (copy attached). Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The following letters were discussed.

Letter 14 - Letter received February 19, 2009, from George Blum, Cerrone Associates, Inc., Application for Funding from USDA-Rural Development for the Wastewater System Improvement Project which was signed and mailed back to Cerrone Associates, Inc., on March 9, 2009.

Letter 39 - Letter and check to the District from Travelers Insurance for the Matheny Motors waterline and fire hydrant leak that occurred in December. The check was in the amount of \$4,074.53.

Letter 52 - Copy of a letter dated March 6, 2009, to Sandra Squires, PSC enclosing Tariff Form 6-A Certificate of Separate Mailing of Notice to Customers of Change in Tariff Sewer Rule 19A Rate increase.

Letter 73 - Copy of a letter dated March 12, 2009, to Sandra Squires, PSC, enclosing copies of Agreements between the City of Parkersburg and Mineral Wells PSD, per request of Amy Swan, PSC. Copy of a letter was mailed to the City of Parkersburg and Cerrone Associates, Inc.

Letter 76 - Copy of Memo faxed to Dianne Wolfe, Bowles Rice that the District mailed to its water customers Notice of Filing for the Miscellaneous Water Improvement Project.

Mrs. Dyer reported that Pete Lopez, with the Public Service Commission, has been in the Districts office conducting an audit for a sewer rate increase. He informed Mrs. Dyer that he would have to write the District up because of the sale of the 1997 truck that was sold. He informed the office that the District needs to receive a Permission of Consent when it sells assets.

Mrs. Dyer informed the Board that Mr. Stewart had been reappointed to the Board until 2015.

Mrs. Dyer discussed with the Board the mass mailing concerning the rate increase was completed with the joint effort of Mr. Anderson's help due to him being on lite-duty from an injury he receive while off duty.

Mr. Anderson reported that the repairs had been made at the Rt. 21 Lift Station. The cost of that repair was \$6,722.60. The District did receive one-half of this cost from Ron's Porta Jon Service.

Mr. Lett made a request for an executive session. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. Mr. Radabaugh recessed the meeting at 5:30 p.m.

Mr. Baldwin excused himself from the meeting.

The meeting was reconvened at 5:45 by Mr. Radabaugh. He announced that no motions had been made during the executive session.

Mr. Lett made a motion that effective January 1, 2010, all employees receive a (\$.50) fifty cent per hour rate increase. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Purchasing property from Mr. Mulinex for the Parkersburg tie-in was discussed, but no dollar amount was decided.

Mr. Anderson discussed with the Board that the West Virginia Dept. of Highways will be at the District's office on March 26, 2009, at 10:00 a.m. to discuss the Barnett Bridge Project.

Mr. Anderson discussed with the Board a situation at the Paul Mohr property. It seems that Mohrs have installed a small sewer grinder in their garage apartment to handle the sewage, but does not pay a sewer rate. They are in the process of renting the apartments now and the District will be receiving sewage from this complex. The Board agrees that the District needs to be charging this complex a sewer charge.

There have been two fires in the District during the month. The Fire Dept. was somewhat concerned about the pressure at the hydrants. One fire was on Butcher Bend and one was on Chesterville Rd. Mr. Anderson, Mr. Crites and Mr. Brown checked the static pressure at the hydrants on Butcher Bend and Chesterville Rd. The pressure on Butcher Bend was 68 PSI at Wayne Meadows's pit and 40 PSI at the meter pit of the old Hunt Club. The static pressure on Chesterville Road in front of J. Tracewell residence is 95 PSI. The fire department had three trucks connected to three hydrants at the same time. There was so much pull on the lines that the water line on Butcher Bend busted creating low pressure for fighting the fire.

All business having been discussed, Mr. Lett made a motion the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Stewart
