Mr. Anderson reported on the following items.

The electrical storm took out the Bar Screen at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. It appears that the cost of repairing the damage done will be in the neighborhood of \$4500.00. The storm knocked out the Holiday Inn Express Lift Station causing approximately \$1200.00 worth of damage there.

The District had to rip-rap two creek banks, one on Sams Creek, the other on Chesterville Rd. Cost of the rip-rap on Sams Creek was \$2,586.00 and the one on Chesterville Rd. was \$946.43.

The two tank sites - Mineral Wells Hill and Bogal Ridge - have been graveled.

The flow meter that the Smoke - Testers were using is being rebuilt at this time.

All business having been discussed, Mr. Lett made a motion the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Radabaugh adjourned the meeting at 5:35 p.m.
