Read minutes of regular board meeting from September 15, 2004. R. J. Mullenix moved to accept minutes. H. E. Seufer second. Unanimous.

R. J. Mullenix moved to accept the financial reports for September 30, 2004. H. E. Seufer second. Unanimous.

Discussed Wastewater Project. Jim Mayles provided an update and an estimated budget update. A substantial completion walk through of Contract 5 is tentatively scheduled for November 8<sup>th</sup>. Gale Smith has said he will have the change orders for contracts 1, 2 and 3 to Cerrone by October 29, 2004. Discussed change orders 4, 5, and the Certificate of Substantial Completion for contract 4. Jonathan provided an update of the inspection budget. Jonathan asked the board to increase the inspection budget and advise him what level of inspection would be acceptable, so that he could determine how many inspectors to provide and calculate the increase for the budget. Mr. Seufer explained that Thrasher was hired to inspect the project, it is their responsibility to determine how many inspectors are needed to provide a quality job.
