Kelley Sanders gave an update on the sewer project. The North Hills city council is meeting on December 10. Mayor Dale Baumgartner has advised that the council will review the information Union Williams PSD has submitted to them concerning the septicity of their sewer. They have also reached out to engineering firms for advice. Mr. Baumgartner then stated he would report back to Union Williams PSD with their decision on how to handle their septicity issues.

After discussion, a decision was made that we should implement the installation of the chemicals at the North Hills lift station, to avoid further damage to our system, until we can move forward with a long term solution.
