- A) Installed 3 water taps since the last Board meeting. There are 2 water taps to be installed. This gives us 62 water taps for 2001. The District has installed 1 sewer tap since the last Board meeting. There is 0 sewer tap to be installed. This gives us 9 sewer taps for 2001.
- B) Repaired one service line leak.
- C) Fixed sewer and leak sites.
- D) Completed work orders, spotted lines, set meters.

It was reported what Rod and Bill have been working on:

September Water Pumped to System: 23,655,000 Gallons
Homewood Booster Station: 174,000 Gallons
New England Booster Station: 1,501,000 Gallons

High Water Usage and Day: 906,000 on 09/20 Low Water Usage and Day: 906,000 on 09/26

Experienced 100,000 gallon overflow at New England Tower due to a level instrument problem.
