BUSINESS: Prayer by Jim Cox.

A) Moved by Dave Steele, seconded by Lee Johnson that the minutes of the Board meeting of May 8, 2003 meeting be approved. Passed unanimously.

### **DISCUSSION OF DISTRICT HAPPENINGS:**

It was reported what has been happening in the District:

- A) Installed 2 water taps since the last Board meeting. There are 10 water taps to be installed. This gives us 8 water taps for 2003. The District has installed 2 sewer taps since the last Board meeting. There is 1 sewer tap to be installed. This gives us 4 sewer taps for 2003.
- B) Fixed 1 leak on Pine Street today.
- C) Capped off a sewer service on Route 95 where the house was torn down and they put in a new building.
- D) Lowered sewer manhole in Somer Villa.
- E) Reset new pump in West Pump Station that had been out of service.
- F) Completed work orders, spotted lines, set meters.

## **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

- A) Moved by Dave Steele, seconded by Lee Johnson that all bills be approved as reviewed by management and the Board, in addition to all fund transfers as presented. Passed unanimously.
- B) Moved by Dave Steele, seconded by Lee Johnson that the District adopt the Federal Guideline for the reimbursement of gasoline mileage if an employee uses their own vehicle. Passed unanimously.
- C) Looked at information that we are going to submit to the Public Service Commission reference to the rate relief and project costs.
- D) The District has sent in our application to the Infrastructure Council for action at their June meeting with a final recommendation in early July. With that in hand we will have everything that we need to submit to the Public Service Commission to convert our filing to a formal case.

- E) The District has received from the Public Service Commission's Commissioners their final ruling concerning the Wellesley sewer system. They have ruled that the Wellesley Homeowner's Association is to file for a certificate to operate a utility within the next sixty (60) days. The District is to apply for a bulk tariff rate for sewage service within the next sixty (60) days. Jim Cox's feeling is that our sewer rate is based upon a customer charge and a flow charge per one thousand gallon of sewage. Jim suggests that we file for the same rate for bulk usage as we have for everyone else. There really is no difference between them and any other customer, other than a larger user for us to treat their waste. The Board agreed with Jim and instructed him to apply for the bulk rate being the same as our present rate as soon as our accountant gets back from vacation.
- F) Discussion concerning an employee and his disability pay.
- G) Discussion of letters received concerning the C-8 litigation.
- H) Meeting adjourned.
