BUSINESS: Prayer by Paul Smith.

A) Moved by Roger Martin, seconded by Paul Smith that the minutes of the Board meeting of November 4, 2004 be approved. Passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION OF DISTRICT HAPPENINGS:

It was reported what has been happening in the District:

- A) Installed 1 water tap since the last Board meeting. There are 6 water taps to be installed. This gives us 56 water taps for 2004. The District has installed 0 sewer taps since the last Board meeting. There are 2 sewer taps to be installed. This gives us 12 sewer taps for 2004.
- B) Repaired two leaks.
- C) Replaced one hydrant in Ryanwood and installed a main line valve.
- D) Smoked Pointe West and ran sewer camera looking for a break in the sewer line. Only found problem with customers service line.
- E) Completed work orders, spotted lines, set meters.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

- A) Moved by Roger Martin, seconded by Paul Smith that all bills be approved as reviewed by management and the Board, in addition to all fund transfers as presented. Passed unanimously.
- B) The District will be closed for Thanksgiving and the day afterwards. It should be noted that the employees trade one of the February holidays for the day after Thanksgiving.
- C) Moved by Roger Martin, seconded by Paul Smith that the District accept the October 2004 financial statements as prepared by Philip R. Postlewait, Jr., CPA. Passed unanimously.
- D) Jim checked with the Public Service Commission on whether the District could bill, in advance, instead of in arrears for water and sewer service to our customers. The answer was no that no water or sewer utility could do so nor was it provided for in the rules. The other question that was asked was whether the District could make the property owner the only person able to sign for service even if it is for a rental unit. Again, the answer was no that it was illegal and discriminatory.

- E) Mr. Argabrite asked about the fact that he is getting a sewer odor coming from the roof vents on certain days. Jim stated that he would do some checking to see if there was anything that readily looked suspicious.
- F) Meeting adjourned.
