A) Moved by Roger Martin, seconded by Jerry Martin that the minutes of the Board meeting of July 27, 2006 be approved. Passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION OF DISTRICT HAPPENINGS:

It was reported what has been happening in the District:

- A) Installed 5 water taps since the last Board meeting. There are 4 water taps to be installed. This gives us 42 water taps for 2006. Installed 0 sewer taps since the last Board meeting. The District has 0 sewer taps to be installed. This gives us 5 sewer taps for 2006.
- B) Did turn offs and turn ons.
- C) Repaired leaking hydrant valve.
- D) Working on property restoration.
- E) Inspecting sewer at Westwood.
- F) Repaired four service line leaks.
- G) Did maintenance work on the Jimmy.
- H) Completed work orders, spotted lines, set meters.

It was reported what Bill and Rod have been working on:

A) July Water Pumped to System:32,428,000 GallonsHomewood Booster Station:388,183 GallonsNew England Booster Station:2,556,600 GallonsHigh Water Usage and Day:1,349,000 on 07/28Low Water Usage and Day:784,000 on 07/09

Experienced no overflows.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

A) Moved by Jerry Martin, seconded by Roger Martin that all bills be approved as reviewed by management and the Board, in addition to all fund transfers as presented. Passed unanimously.

- B) Moved by Roger Martin, seconded by Jerry Martin that the District sign the substantial completion certificates for all contracts associated with the water project. Passed unanimously.
- C) Residents of Homewood Road were here to discuss the pressure problems they have since the Larkmead tank went on line. The Board told them that they would look into it and get back to them at the next Board meeting.
- D) A question was asked about the repair to the green sand filter. Jim reported that it has been repaired.
- E) The residents of Pleasant Home Road were here to tell the District that they cannot afford the water line. They asked the District for direction from here and were instructed to contact their delegates and senator. In addition Jim will call Charleston to see if there is any grant money that might be available to help them and report at the next Board meeting.
- F) Question was asked about a water quality report. Jim reported that the District does an annual report just before July of each year in the newspaper. It was suggested that the District consider doing a report as was given to us concerning a District in Connecticut.
- G) A question was asked about the Wood County Commissions writing of a letter to the Public Service Commission (PSC) in reference to our Granular Activated Carbon Filter. Roger Martin responded by stating that he had been contacted by the County Commission and asked if there was anything that they might do to help the process along. Mr. Martin suggested that they right a letter asking the PSC to expedite the process.
