DISCUSSION OF DISTRICT HAPPENINGS:

It was reported what has been happening in the District:

- A) Installed 6 water taps since the last Board meeting. There is 1 water tap to be installed. This gives us 62 water taps for 2006. The District has installed 3 sewer taps since the last Board meeting. There are 0 sewer taps to be installed. This gives us 10 sewer taps for 2006.
- B) Helping Gary at the well field.
- C) Did turn offs and turn ons.
- D) Buried blow off in Wildwood.
- E) Repaired 2 main line leaks and 3 service line leaks.
- F) Changing meters.
- G) Ran sewer camera at Somer Villa and Bethel Place for services.
- H) Worked on yard restoration.
- I) Inspecting sewer installations.
- J) Ran sewer smoke tester in Lubeck.
- K) Raising of water meters.
- L) Maintenance of vehicles.
- M) Completed work orders, spotted lines, set meters.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

This is a one time offer in which the residents are to let the District know within 30 days if they want the booster pump. It is understood that once the booster pump has been delivered to the resident any maintenance, electric, etc. cost is the residents cost. The Resident and District will sign an agreement outlining the understanding of the agreement. The residents will have 60 days to install and send the invoices to the District for processing. Passed unanimously.
