- B) Water Project Nothing to report

- D) Question was asked about the balancing of the Granular Activated Carbon filter and it was stated that this has worked itself out after replacing the air/vac valve and test results show no C-8 in the District's finished water.
- E) The District has filed for a grant from Homeland Security for a fence around the electrical platform at the wellfield.
