## **DISCUSSION OF DISTRICT HAPPENINGS:**

It was reported what has been happening in the District:

- A) Installed 4 water taps since the last Board meeting. There are 0 water taps to be installed. This gives us 36 water taps for 2007. The District has installed 0 sewer taps since the last Board meeting. There are 0 sewer taps to be installed. This gives us 3 sewer taps for 2007.
- B) Did turn offs and turn ons.
- C) Repaired 0 main line leaks and 7 service line leaks.
- D) Ran sewer jetter at Bethel Place and Ros Mar on the sewer mains.
- E) Worked on testing water meters.
- F) Worked on laying water line on the Pleasant Home South Fork Water Project.
- G) Completed work orders, spotted lines, set meters.

## **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

- A) Moved by Jerry Martin, seconded by Paul Smith that all bills be approved as reviewed by management and the Board, in addition to all fund transfers as presented. Passed unanimously.
- B) Contractor is working on pulling rope, etc. to place the fiber optic cable to the well field. Now waiting on the rains to quit.

C) Received bids on three backhoes. the results are as follows:

Rish Equipment \$76,800 MH Equipment \$73,900 Leslie Equipment \$59,900

Moved by Jerry Martin, seconded by Paul Smith that the District accept the bid from Leslie Equipment for \$59,900 for a 310 SJ. Passed unanimously.

- D) The District continues to lay water line on the Pleasant Home South Fork Water Project. We are within about 2,000 feet of being done. The weather has caused delays recently.
- E) Moved by Paul Smith, seconded by Jerry Martin that the District accept the October 2007 financial statements as prepared by Philip R. Postlewait, Jr., CPA. Passed unanimously.
- F) Moved by Jerry Martin, seconded by Paul Smith that the District adopt the meeting dates for 2008 as presented. Passed unanimously.
- G) Moved by Paul Smith, seconded by Jerry Martin that the District appoints either William Gibbs or Roderick Carmichael to sign the WV/NPDES water form and Charles Vincent or Mark Lewis to sign the WV/NPDES wastewater form instead of the Chairman and with the oversight of the District Manager. Passed unanimously.
- H) Moved by Jerry Martin, seconded by Paul Smith that the District adopt the agreement between the Commissioners, Ronald D. Miller and his wife Carol Ann Miller in reference to the providing of health insurance as prepared by Richard Hayhurst. Passed unanimously.
  - Jerry reported that the District had received a \$15,000 check from the state for the New England Ridge Bonner Water Line Project. It was presented to the Wood County Commission and Lubeck PSD today.
