Moved by Jerry Martin, seconded by Paul Smith that Roger Martin be elected to the position of Treasurer. Passed unanimously.
- C) Moved by Paul Smith, seconded by Jerry Martin that the minutes of the Board meeting of December 13, 2007 be approved. Passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION OF DISTRICT HAPPENINGS:

It was reported what the field has been doing in the District:

- A) Installed 0 water taps since the last Board meeting. There are 0 water taps to be installed. This gave us 36 water taps for 2007 and 0 water taps for 2008. The District has installed 0 sewer taps since the last Board meeting. There are 0 sewer taps to be installed. This gave us 3 sewer taps for 2007.
- B) Maintenance of vehicles.
- C) Repaired 0 main line leaks and 1 service line leaks.
- D) Did Turn offs and turn ons.
- E) Tested meters and did meter inventory.
- F) Completed work orders, spotted lines, set meters.

- D) Moved by Jerry Martin, seconded by Paul Smith that the District sign the Grant Agreement with the State of West Virginia for the well field fencing. Passed unanimously.
- E) Moved by Paul Smith, seconded by Jerry Martin that the District accept the November 2007 financial statements as prepared by Philip R. Postlewait, Jr., CPA. Passed unanimously.
- F) Well Cleaning bids:
