DISCUSSION OF DISTRICT HAPPENINGS:

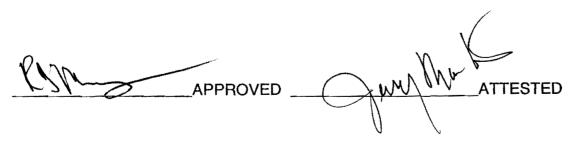
It was reported what has been done in the District:

- A) Installed 4 water taps since the last Board meeting. There are 0 water taps to be installed. This gives us 33 water taps for 2009. The District has installed 0 sewer taps since the last Board meeting. There are 0 sewer taps to be installed. This gives us 8 sewer taps for 2009.
- B) Repaired 0 main line and 2 service line leaks.
- C) Completed the tie in from College Hill Road to Middle Fork of Lee Creek. The line has been flushed, tested and approved and is now in service.
- D) Finished black topping on Middle Fork.
- E) Replaced a busted meter well.
- F) Installed a new grinder pump at West Pump Station.
- G) Completed work orders, spotted lines, set meters.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

- A) Moved by Roger Martin, seconded by Jerry Martin that all bills be approved as reviewed by management and the Board, in addition to all fund transfers as presented. Passed unanimously.
- B) Lake Washington Club Sewer Richard went over the project status. Mr. Robinson brought the last permit application, late in the meeting, for our signature and a check.
- C) Wadesville Water Project The District continues to work on obtaining easements and user agreements.
- D) Corp of Engineers at the well field The District has been in contact with the Governor's office again and will be attending the IJDC meetings this week and next to try and get a funding package approved.

- E) Moved by Jerry Martin, seconded by Roger Martin that the Board go into Executive Session for a discussion concerning an existing lawsuit. Passed unanimously.
- F) Paul noted that the Board was back out of Executive Session with no action taken.
- G) James Swesey has requested permission to appear before the Board to talk about a lien that was placed on his property due to the water project that took water to Belleville and was funded by RUS. After discussion, Richard informed Mr. Swesey that, even if the Board was inclined to do something about the lien, they cannot due to statutory laws. It was decided to see if we could get him into a payment agreement to get the bill paid.
- H) Phil reported that Mr. Altman would be working at his office next week on the audit.
