It was reported what has been happening in the District:




- B) District continues the mowing of properties.
- C) Repaired yards, stoned driveways.
- D) Repaired 1 service line and 0 main line water leaks.
- E) Did turn offs and turn ons.
- F) Repaired one main line valve.
- G) Graveled the lane to the New England Ridge water tank.
- H) Completed work orders, spotted lines, set meters.
