GENERAL BUSINESS:

• The minutes for February 11th and February 25th, a special meeting for the 10th, the 18th and the 5th. A motion was made by Roger Martin and seconded by Jim Eaton to approve the minutes as sent out. Motion carried unanimously.

DISCUSSION OF DISTRICT HAPPENINGS:

Randy mentioned how much we appreciate John Tennant's help in acquiring the easements, he has been instrumental in being able to get this project squared away. User agreements were also discussed and the manager reported that there were 152 user agreements that had been secured

Also discussed were required changes in the way that we conduct our maintenance program as well as revisions in the way that we reinvest in our system via capital reinvestment plan.
