Mr. Grinstead presented to the Board a Certificate of Substantial Competition for work completed at Still Road, Little Still Run Road and the Walker / Progress Ridge water flow Control Valves. A motion made by Commissioner Law and seconded by Commissioner Summers passed unanimously.

<u>Sewer Division Rate Review:</u> Mr. Grinstead reported to the Board that the District staff is preparing for a working meeting with the Wood County Commission.
