Freeport Area Waterline Extension Project: Mr. Brabham presented to the board for consideration Drawdown #9 in the amount of \$4,560.12 for MOVRC administrative fees and reimbursement to Claywood Park PSD for project related costs. A motion to accept was made by commissioner Summers and seconded by commissioner Cox, passed unanimously.

Mr. Brabham reported that 12 of the 14 rights-of-ways have been signed and the property had been purchased for the water booster station. The project team anticipates bidding out the project by the end of August and construction to begin before the end of the year.
