
Having no other scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 10:03 A.M.





**A RESOLUTION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE
PARKERSBURG/WOOD COUNTY HOME CONSORTIUM FOR THE PERIOD OF
JULY 1, 2025, TO JUNE 30, 2026
AND
APPROVING THE FY 2025-2029 FIVE-YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN
AND THE FY 2025 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN
AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF THE PLANS WITH THE
U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)**

Whereas, TITLE II of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 provides for the creation of the HOME Investment Partnership Program, hereinafter referred to as HOME; and

Whereas, the HOME regulations promulgated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (hereinafter referred to as HUD) under 24 CFR Part 92 authorizes units of general local government to enter into Housing Consortium Cooperation Agreements; and

Whereas, there is a continued need throughout Wood County, West Virginia to provide affordable housing for low- and moderate-income residents; and

Whereas, the City of Parkersburg's Development Department has prepared a FY 2025-2029 Five-Year Consolidated Plan and FY 2025 Annual Action Plan that proposes how the entitlement grant funds will be expended to address the housing needs identified in the Five-Year Consolidated Plan; and

Whereas, a draft of the FY 2025-2029 Five-Year Consolidated Plan and FY 2025 Annual Action Plan was on public display from June 18 through July 17, 2025, and a series of public meetings were held on the said Plans and the comments of various agencies, groups, and citizens were taken into consideration in the preparation of the final document; and

Whereas, the Wood County Commission, the City of Parkersburg, the City of Vienna, and the City of Williamstown, West Virginia have formed the Parkersburg/Wood County HOME Consortium (hereinafter referred to as the Consortium) which has been designated as a Participating Jurisdiction under the HOME Program thereby entitling the Consortium to annual funding; and


Whereas, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has advised the Parkersburg-Wood County HOME Consortium that under Fiscal Year 2025, the Consortium is eligible to apply for an entitlement grant under the HOME Investment Partnership Program in the amount of \$252,291.13; and

Whereas, the Consortium recognizes the need to obtain funding for affordable housing and has identified the HOME Program as a source of funds to meet this need.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Wood County Commission that:

1. The Wood County Commission will continue to cooperate with the City of Parkersburg in a Consortium for participation in the HOME Program; and
2. A copy of this Resolution is to be submitted in the request to HUD to approve funding of the Parkersburg/Wood County HOME Consortium for the above fiscal year 2025 HOME Investment Partnership Program.

**MOTION TO ENLARGE THE TIME
WITHIN WHICH TO SUBMIT FINAL REPORT OR SETTLEMENT**

Now comes Kyra L. Smith, Executrix by counsel, Thomas R. Zimmerman and pursuant to WVRC 44-1-14a, and respectfully requests the court to grant an enlargement of the time within which she may file the full and final settlement and alternatively, submit Waiver(s) of Settlement(s) of the Estate of Richard Wilhelm, Jr. and Kathryn L. Wilhelm, and would show the following:

Relevant Timeline

1. Last Will and Testaments of both Kathryn L. Wilhelm and Richard Wilhelm, Jr., were admitted to Probate by the County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia on the 13th day of July, 2020.
2. Kyra L. Smith was appointed as Executrix of the Estates of both Kathryn L. Wilhelm and Richard Wilhelm Jr., and is administering both such Estates as provided by law.
3. On or about June 24, 2021 Wilhelms filed their Petition to Remove your fiduciary as Executrix of both estates. The unnumbered Petition was referred to William Crichton, VI, Commissioner, for the purpose of conducting hearings thereon and making findings of fact and recommendations to this court.
4. On or about the 24th day of June 2021, Richard Wilhelm, III and Mary Rebecca (hereinafter "Wilhelms") filed Civil Action 21-C-150, in the Circuit Court of Wood County, West Virginia, against Kyra Smith individually, in her capacity as Executrix of the Estates of Kathryn L. Wilhelm and Richard Wilhelm, Jr., in her capacity as Trustee of the Kyra L. Smith Family Trust U/A dated May 29, 2009 (hereinafter "Trust", and against other parties, alleging claims against Smith individually as Executrix and as otherwise.

5. On or about the 27th day of October 2021, in Civil Action 21-C-150, the Trust filed a cross-claim against the Estate of Richard Wilhelm, Jr. In that cross-claim, the Trust averred that notwithstanding the conveyance to the Trust of the aforementioned real property by Richard Wilhelm, Jr., and Kathryn L. Wilhelm, for the remainder of his life, Richard Wilhelm, Jr.:
6. On January 23, 2024 Wilhelms filed suit in the Circuit Court of Wood County, West Virginia against Kyra L. Smith as Executrix as Case No. 22-C-77, seeking to set aside certain deeds to real estate owned by the Decedents in the above estates and conveyed to the Trust.
7. On June 10, 2022, Wilhelms filed Case No. 22-C-134 in the Circuit Court of Wood County, West Virginia seeking partition of certain property jointly owned and owned by the decedents and your executrix and Richard Wilhelm, III. Although not an asset of the Estate(s), the status of such real estate is referred to in the respective appraisements of the estates.
8. On August 19, 2022 Kyra L. Smith filed her Partition suit in the Circuit Court of Wood County as 22-C-188, respecting real estate owned, in part, by the decedents during their lifetimes. Although not an asset of the estates, disposition and status of such real estate is referred to in the respective appraisements of the estates.
9. On January 23, 2024, your executrix filed Civil Action 24-C-19 in which your fiduciary sought to recover certain assets of the estate of Richard Wilhelm, Jr from Richard Wilhelm, III.

Status of Litigation

- a. In said Civil Action No. 21-C-150, the Circuit Court of Wood County, West Virginia appointed George Y. Chandler, an attorney practicing at the Bar of the Court as Special Commissioner to ascertain and report to the Court the state of the account between the Trust and the Estate of Richard Wilhelm, Jr. Hearings were held before the Special Commissioner on September 13, 2022, and June 5, 2023. The Wilhelms were present in person, and by counsel, at such hearings and participated therein. After considering the evidence, Special Commissioner Chandler made his findings of fact and report to the Court in which he made a finding of fact that on the Promissory Note the Trust had overpaid the Estate of Richard Wilhelm, Jr., by Seven Hundred and Three Thousand, Seven Hundred and Ninety-Five Dollars (\$703,795.00), and that as of June 5, 2023, the Trust was owed additional prejudgment interest in the amount of Four Hundred and Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$470,000.00), at the rate of 7% per annum. (Total due the Trust as of June 5, 2023: \$1,173,795.00). The Circuit Court granted the Trust's Motion for Adoption of Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in the Report of Special Commissioner on December 1, 2023, and the Trust's Motion for Certification

- Pursuant to West Virginia R.C.P. 54(b), on January 8, 2024, granting judgment in favor of the Trust as recommended by the Special Commissioner.
- b. Richard Wilhelm, Jr. and Mary Rebecca Wilhelm Wilhelms filed a Motion for New Trial and for Other Relief from the order entering judgment in favor of the Trust, and from the order adopting the Special Commissioner's Report and directing payment, and a Motion for Stay of the Court's judgment in favor of the Trust against the Estate of Richard Wilhelm, Jr., on January 23, 2024. The Wood County Circuit Court denied all of those Motions on February 27, 2024.
 - c. filed a Notice of Appeal to appeal the Circuit Court's February 27, 2024 Order to the West Virginia Intermediate Court of Appeals.
 - d. By Memorandum of Opinion dated January 25, 2025, the West Virginia Intermediate Court of Appeals Affirmed the Circuit Court's Judgment and entry of Judgment of February 27, 2024.
10. On October 6, 2023, the Court, In Case No. 21-C-150, the court issued an injunction against your fiduciary, Kyra L. Smith as follows: "The Executor (sic) is ENJOINED from conducting a sale of the personal property of the Estates of Kathryn Wilhelm and Richard Wilhelm, Jr. until further Order of the Court".
 11. With respect to that unnumbered Petition which seeks to remove your fiduciary as Executrix of the above identified estates, the matter was referred by the Wood County Commission to William Crichton, VI, an attorney-at-law and a Fiduciary Commissioner of such Commission, for the purpose of his conducting hearings thereon and making findings of fact and recommendations to the Wood County Commission. William Crichton, VI, the Fiduciary Commissioner, after conducting evidentiary hearings over a five (5) day period, made findings of fact and recommendations to this honorable court in which your commissioner, in such capacity concluded that there was no basis in fact to remove your fiduciary, Kyra L. Smith as Executrix of either estate.
 12. William Crichton, VI, stated in his report to the Wood County Commission: "22. The undersigned Fiduciary Commissioner concludes, based on the totality of evidence herein, that insufficient evidence was presented to prove Petitioner's allegations that the Executrix has engaged in fraudulent schemes in relation to the Estates, converted any asset of the Estates to her own benefit, or been unjustly enriched as the result of her administration of the Estates. 23. The undersigned Fiduciary Commissioner further concludes, based on the totality of the evidence herein, that in relation to any other allegation in the Petition to Remove Executrix (but not specifically addressed in these Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law), there is insufficient evidence to justify the removal of the Executrix..."
 13. Cases Styled 21-C-150, 24-C-77, 24-C-134 and 24-C-188 in the Circuit Court of Wood County remain pending. Case No. PR-C-23-0001052 in the

Broward County FL Probate Court remains pending with estate funds, (215,610.63) held in escrow and to be released to Kyra L. Smith, as Executrix of the Estate of Richard Wilhelm, Jr.

14. The undersigned, counsel for the Executrix represents to this court that the parties, which include Kyra L. Smith as Executrix of the Estate of Richard Wilhelm, Jr, Kyra L. Smith as Executrix of the Estate of Kathryn L. Wilhelm, Kyle Smith Trustee of the Kyra L. Smith Family Trust U/A dated May 29, 2009, Richard Wilhelm, III and Mary Rebecca Wilhelm have entered into substantive negotiations directed toward a comprehensive settlement of all matters including finalizing the estates pending before this Commission. Such settlement negotiation has resulted in a 33-page agreement which has been circulated among and between the parties. It is anticipated that closing will occur within the time extension requested in this motion.

15. The undersigned prays that this court issue an Order which enlarges the time within which Kyra L. Smith may submit her final Settlement in the Estate of Richard Wilhelm, Jr. and the final Settlement of the Estate of Kathryn L. Wilhelm or alternatively, submit Waiver of Settlement of each estate through December 31, 2025.

SECOND MOTION TO DISMISS FOR FAILURE TO PROSECUTE

Now comes Sue Ellen Burton, *Administratrix* of the Estate of Arthur L. Gifford, II, by counsel submitting this Second Motion for Dismissal for Failure to Prosecute and requesting the dismissal of the Petition for Elective Share filed by Sara Gifford for failure to prosecute this action. For the last three years, Sara Gifford has failed to take any action in this matter which is causing harm to the estate.

Undersigned counsel previously filed a Motion to Dismiss for failure to Prosecute on March 6, 2024, and the motion was set for hearing on April 18, 2024. See attached exhibit A. However, Sara Gifford asked for continuance of the hearing and has again not prosecuted the matter in over a year since the last scheduled hearing therefore bringing the total time period of inaction up to three years which is causing harm and substantial prejudice to the estate.

Counsel for Sara Gifford advised Sara Gifford would likely be dismissing the Petition for Elective Share but has not done so. Instead, this matter has lingered without any action for over three years.

Accordingly, Sue Ellen Burton, *Administratrix* of the Estate of Arthur L. Gifford, II hereby requests this matter be dismissed for failure to prosecute.



Accordingly, it is hereby Ordered that the Petition for Elective Share filed by Sara Gifford is hereby dismissed for failure to prosecute.


