At 9:30 A.M. the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by James E. Colombo and passed, approved Erroneous Assessment Applications regarding real and personal property. Copies are attached to these minutes and shall be made a part thereof.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing regarding the Estate of Bernard Honaker. Richard Smith, Attorney for Beverly Moore, was present and discussed an issue with claims in the estate. After discussion, the County Commission, upon a motion made by James E. Colombo and seconded by David Blair Couch and passed, granted the relief requested by the Executrix. (Probate Order)

At 9:45 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing regarding the Estate of Gene E. Cooper: Attorney Blaine Myers, counsel for Denise McClear, asked the Commission to appoint her as sole Executrix for the Estate in place of Pamila L. Cooper. Justin Raber, counsel, was present for Richard Sneigle, who was listed in the Will to qualify as Co-Executor with Denise

McLear, should Pamila be unwilling or unable to serve. Mr. Raber requested additional time for the two parties to work together and settle the Estate. After discussion, the County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by James E. Colombo, and passed, Ordered that this hearing be continued for thirty (30) days. (Probate Order)

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by James E. Colombo, seconded by David Blair Couch and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE David Blair Couch, on behalf of the County Commission, to sign the Request for Reimbursement in regard to the Victims of Crime Assistance Grant Number 25-VA-076. The Request for Reimbursement is for six thousand four hundred sixteen dollars and sixty-six cents (\$6,416.66) for the month of June, 2025. Documentation pertaining to the Victims of Crime Advocate Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. (Order A/3171)

At 9:56 A.M., James Nemitz met with the County Commission to update them on the WV School of Osteopathic Medicine.

At 10:15 A.M., the County Commission met with Paul Hoblitzel from the River Road Music Festival. He requested their approval for alcohol sales during their two-day event.

At 10:19 A.M., Dale McEwuen, Director of the E-911 Center, met with the County Commission to request that they allow a wage increase for their dispatchers.

At 10:30 A.M., Shayne Brabham from Claywood Park Public Service District met with the County Commission to discuss their upcoming rate increase request for water and sewer.

Having no other scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 10:41 A.M.

UNDER W.VA. CODE §44-2-6, HEARING DATED JULY 17, 2025

On or about May 22, 2025, the Executrix filed her *Personal Representative's Denial Of Claims Under W.Va. Code §44-2-6* with the Clerk of this Commission. Simultaneously therewith, the aforesaid *Denial* and *Notice of Hearing* was sent to purported claimants of the Estate Bank of America, N.A. and Capital One, N.A. by certified mail, return receipt requested to the address provided to the Clerk of this Commission by each respective purported claimant.


The Commission held a hearing on the above matter on July 17, 2025. Appearing at said hearing was Executrix Beverly Moore; Richard D. Smith, Jr., counsel for the Estate. Appearing for the Commission was Commissioners James E. Colombo and David Blair Couch.


Whereupon Counsel for the Estate represented to the Commission that pursuant to W.Va. Code §44-2-5, the purported claims at issue were not filed with the Clerk of this Commission in accordance with W.Va. Code. Specifically, a claim against the Estate is required per W.Va. Code §44-2-5 to be "itemized, verified by affidavit, accompanied by proper vouchers and shall state the character of the claim[.]" In regards to vouchers for open accounts, the same must be in the form of "an itemized copy of the account." W.Va. Code §44-2-5. Counsel for the Estate further represented that the purported claims relate to open accounts and the purported claimants failed to include an itemized copy of the accounts. As such, the claimants have failed to meet the requirements of a proper valid claim against this Estate. Proof of notice of today's hearing was provided to the Commissioners in the form of USPS return receipts, both of which were made part of the file.

Whereupon, the Commissioners reviewed the Clerk's file. Questions were asked to Counsel for the Estate and accordingly answered. The Commission confirmed that the Executrix's objection to the claims was timely filed and that notice of the objection and of today's hearing was made to the purported claimants. The Commissioners note that no appearance was made on behalf of either claimant.

Whereupon, in consideration of the matters set forth before the Commission and further such matters argued at the hearing, a Motion was made by JAMES E. COLOMBO and seconded by, and made unanimous by DAVID BLAIR COUCH, to grant the relief requested by the Executrix. Wherefore, the purported claim of Bank of America, N.A. dated April 28, 2025 and received by the Clerk of this Commission on May 6, 2025 in the amount of \$6,840.00 is hereby denied. Wherefore, the purported claim of Capital One, N.A. dated May 9, 2025 and received by the Clerk of this Commission on May 13, 2025 in the amount of \$10,032.94 is hereby denied.
