Whereas, workplaces that welcome the talents of all people, including those with disabilities, are essential to building an inclusive community and a strong economy;

In this spirit, the Wood County Commission, West Virginia, recognizes National Disability Employment Awareness Month to raise awareness about disability employment issues and celebrate the many and varied contributions of people with disabilities. Activities during this month will reinforce the value and talent that people with disabilities bring to our workplaces and communities, affirming Wood County's commitment to inclusivity.

Whereas, The Arc of the Mid-Ohio Valley operates a Thrift Shop, a Fingerprinting service, and an Artistic Opportunity Center, providing outlets for people to sell their artwork to supplement their income. These venues offer inclusive employment and vocational training opportunities for people with and without disabilities, fostering full inclusion and participation for all, and enhancing our community by recognizing the valuable contributions people with disabilities make every day;

Whereas, The Arc of the Mid-Ohio Valley collaborates with West Virginia Division of Rehabilitation Services and Westbrook, to provide vocational and employment supports;

Therefore, we, the Wood County Commission, does hereby proclaim October, 2025 as National Disability Employment Awareness Month. To the Honorable Patrick Morrisey

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA

I have the honor to request that you issue a requisition to the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania for the extradition of James Brian Mullins who stands charged with *Shoplifting 3rd Offense, West Virginia Code 61-3A-1(a)(2)* which offenses were committed in the County of Wood, of this State, on or about July 2025, and who is now a fugitive from justice of this State and, as I am informed, is now within the jurisdiction of the said State of Pennsylvania, in the County of Washington. The date of birth of said James Brian Mullins, is 04/18/1960; social security number 318-50-5763, a white male, 5'4", gray hair, and blue eyes.

I HEREBY CERTIFY:

- 1. That the full name of the person for whom requisition is asked is James Brian Mullins who will be hereinafter referred to as said accused.
- 2. That said accused was personally and physically present in this State at the time of the commission of said crimes, and to avoid arrest and prosecution, fled from the jurisdiction of this State.
- 3. That in my opinion the ends of public justice require said accused to be brought to this State for trial at the public expense, and I believe I have sufficient evidence to secure the conviction of said accused of said crimes.

4. That this request is made in good faith and not for the purpose of collecting a debt or for any private purpose whatever, and if the requisition now applied for be granted, criminal proceedings shall not be used for any of said objects.

5. That no former application for a requisition for said accused, growing out of the same transaction, has been made.

I annex hereto a certified copy of the Complaint against him with affidavit to the facts thereof by a person having actual knowledge thereof.

I respectfully recommend the Vienna Police Department, or their duly authorized agents, as a proper person to be appointed as agent to bring said accused to this State, and certify said proposed agent has no private interest in the arrest and bringing to this State said accused.
