At 9:30 A.M., there were no public comments.

At 9:31 A.M., Bob and Dottie Enoch from the Wood County Historical Society brought several Wood County 250th United States Anniversary items.

At 9:39 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by James E. Colombo, seconded by James E. Hamric and passed, placed Willis Perry in nomination for reappointment to the West Virginia Route 2 and Interstate 68 Authority. The new term will expire June 30, 2030. (Order A/3299)

At 9:40 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by James E. Colombo and passed, placed the name of Josh Brannon in nomination to fill a vacancy on the Wood County Fire Board, as authorized in West Virginia State Code 7-17-6. (Order A/3300)

At 9:41 A.M., Joe Gonazles, County Clerk, met with the County Commission to request consolidation of election precincts. The consolidation would change the requirement of 307 poll workers to 280 workers. After discussion, the County Commission, upon a motion by James E. Colombo, seconded by James E. Hamric and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE voting consolidation for Precinct Numbers 47, 77, 52, 33, 41, 10, 35, 19, 27, 37A and 38. Said changes were proposed and presented to the County Commission by Wood County Clerk, Joe Gonzales. (Order A/3303)

At 9:50 A.M., Sheriff Rick Woodyard and Gerald Brandsassee from the Sheriff's Department were in attendance to inform the County Commission that several of the new security cameras have been installed and are working great.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by James E. Hamric, seconded by James E. Colombo and passed, adopted a Resolution in reference to Budget Revision No. 4 in the General County Fund Budget for the fiscal year 2025/2026. The Request for Revision to the Approved Budget, being submitted to the West Virginia State Auditor - Chief Inspector Division, Charleston, West Virginia, was signed by Joe Gonzales, Clerk of the County Commission. Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 10:04 A.M.
