

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held December 9, 1980

Present: President, Marvin H. Leach
Commissioner, Holmes R. Shaver
Commissioner, William C. Parrish

At 10:35 a.m. the Commission met with Sheriff, L. W. Bechtold, and Mr. Robert Barrows, Chief Tax Deputy to discuss and review the budget.

At 11:00 a.m. the Commission met with Mr. Pat McMillion to discuss the cable service in Wood County. Mr. McMillion stated to the Commission that he had been informed by Durfee's TV Cable Service that the Wood County Commission was holding up services for the residents of Wood County. Commissioner Parrish stated to Mr. McMillion that the statement made by Durfees was not true, that the County Commission did not have the legal authority to hold them up from suppling the area with the cable service. Commissioner Parrish also added that he had been receiving other calls from concerned citizens who had been given the same information.

Upon receiving the resignation of Wood County Administrator, Leo M. Tyson on November 11, 1980, the Commission interviewed applicants for this position beginning at 2:00 p.m. until 4:30 p.m.


