

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held April 16, 1981

PRESENT: President, Holmes R. Shaver
Commissioner, William C. Parrish
Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley Jr.

At 9:35 a.m. the Commission met with Mr. Greg Harrick, from Burgess & Niple. The purpose of Mr. Harrick's meeting with the Commission was to discuss and review specifications for the renovation of the Court House. Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver suggested that Mr. Harrick meet with the Commission at a later date to discuss the matter in detail and would also give Mr. Harrick more time to compile their recommendations. A meeting was scheduled for Mr. Harrick on Tuesday, April 28, 1981 at 2:30 p.m.

At 11:15 a.m. the Commission met with Mr. Tim Craig and Ms. Jean Luzader from the C.E.T.A. Office in Charleston, WV. The purpose of the meeting with the Commission was to discuss the Governor's Summer Youth Program. Ms. Luzader advised the Commission that they were entitled to an assistant in the C.E.T.A. Office to relieve the handling of paper work involved for the summer youth program. Mr. Craig pointed out to the Commission that the salary of the assistant would be absorbed by the C.E.T.A. Program. Ms. Luzader stated that the position would be for a nine (9) week period. The Commission will be responsible for the hiring of the assistant.

The Commission also received various 1981 Personal Property Tax Tickets and Erroneous Assessments to be impropered for clerical errors. The Commission received and approved the tickets

and forwarded them to the Probate Office to be recorded. Copies are in attachment.

This day came Joseph L. Carrico, Director of the Wood County Community Development and Planning Commission with a Plat of the re-division of lots 32 through 37 in the DuPont Manor Sub-division, as proposed by Paul M. Cochrane, and situate in the Lubeck District.

Upon the motion of Commissioner William C. Parrish, seconded by Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, and made unanimous by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver - it is hereby ORDERED that the aforementioned plat be accepted and recorded as a matter of record.

No bond will be required since no new street, water or sewer lines are necessary.





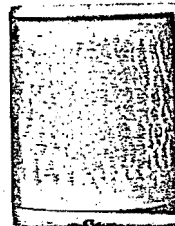
