IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held April 23, 1981

PRESENT: President Pro-Tem, William C. Parrish
Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr.

At 9:12 a.m. the Commission met with Mr. Edward Lehen, Director of Mountwood Park to discuss the installation of a radio in the security car at Mountwood Park, due to the fact that there had been some misunderstandings. The Commission voiced their approval of the installation of the radio and indicated that they would see that the matter was resolved and would certainly work in cooperation with the Sheriff.

Also, the Commission received one (1) 1981 Personal Property Tax Ticket to be impropered for a clerical error. The Commission received and approved the Tax Ticket and forwarded it to the Probate Office to be recorded. A copy is in attachment.

At 10:15 a.m. the Commission met with Judge Donald F. Black to discuss the contract agreement that the Commission had entered into with Advertising Dimensions to presort the mail. Judge Black stated that the state government required that they serve notices by mail and various other types of documents and that these pieces of correspondence must be certified and placed directly into the United States Post Office or a Post Office Box, and that it would not be permissible to have the mail handles by a third party. The Commission informed Judge Black that the contract could be canceled and that would hold the contract until a final decision had been reached.

Purchase Order #4922, to Roberts Inc., in the amount of \$24.00, for the Sheriff's Department.



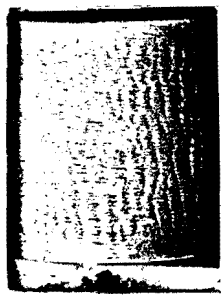


IN RE: CANCELATION OF CONTRACT AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO


