

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held December 8, 1981

PRESENT: President, Holmes R. Shaver

at 9:15 a.m. the Commission met with Ms. Christine Shultz and Mr. Ben McDay of the Commission on Crime, Delinquency and Correction. Ms. Shultz presented the Commission a copy of her daily log. Ms. Shultz also stated that Jo-Ann Johnson had offered her services to help with clerical/secretaril work for her office at no cost. Also, Ms. Shultz presented the Commission with a copy of (Commission of Crime, Delinquency & Correction Monograph) 1st Chapter.

At 10:00 a.m. the Commission met with Rev. Larry Keenan. The purpose of Mr. Keenan's meeting with the Commission was to his objection to the West Virginia Health Systems Agency Regionalization Plan for Wood County. Mr. Keenan told the Commission that Regionalization was unconstitutional. Mr. Keenan told the Commission that the Plan had not worked for Indiana, and he hoped that Wood County would not be a part of it.

At 11:00 a.m. the Commission met with Mr. Robert Gordon. Mr. Gordon met with the Commission to discuss the expansion of the Wood County Court House. Mr. Gordon stated to the Commission his credential in the line of electronics lighting, wiring, etc. Mr. Gordon stated that his purpose of meeting with the Commission was to discourage their building on Parcel #1. Mr. Gordon stated that Parcel #1 had to be reserved for an anchor store. Mr. Gordon

went on to explain to the Commission his thoughts and ideas on renovation of the down-town area, a plan that Gordon stated should be done in stages. Gordon's plan would include a centralized parking area for down-town parking with the shopping area to be geared for pedestrians only. Mr. Gordon again stressed that he was against the Commission building on Parcel #1, and that he would do ever thing possible as a concerned citizen to see that it did not happen. This meeting was taped in it's entirety and is filed in the office of the County Administrator.

The Commission received one (1) 1981 Personal Property Tax Ticket to be impropered for a clerical error. The Commission received and approved the ticket and forwarded it to the Probate Office to be recorded. A copy is in attachment.




