Upon the motion of Commissioner William C. Parrish, seconded by Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., and made unanimous by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver it was ORDERED that the aforementioned bids and quotations be held over for further discussion and review with disposition to be made at a later session of this Commission. A copy of this ORDER is in attachment.

At 10:00 a.m. the Commission witnessed a hearing alledging the competency of Philip F. Reilly. The Commission after examining the petition and documents relating thereto and upon hearing the testimonies of G. Michael Abdella, William Powell, and Father, John R. Lester regarding the statutory notices did find and declare the said Philip F. Reilly to be Incompetent. Mr. Abdella tendered to the Commission an affidavit from Dr. Robert F. Gustke, defining Mr. Reilly's physical condition. Due to the fact that there was no one present showing objection to the appointment of Father, John R. Lester, the Commission unanimously approved the appointment of Father Lester as Committee for Mr. Reilly. A Corporate Surety Bond was set in the amount of \$20,000.00.

The Commission also unanimously accepted the Proposal as submitted by Hattman Glass Service, to add 2" storm proof louvre system to 6 windows in the Boiler Room in lieu of insulated glass in the amount of \$470.00. A copy of this proposal is in attachment.

The Commission also received one (1) 1981 Personal Property Tax Ticket to be impropred for a clerical error. The Commission received and approved the ticket and forwarded it to the Probate Office to be recorded. A copy of this ticket is in attachment.
