Shaver, it was ORDERED that the FEES for keeping and maintaining Prisoners in the Wood County Correctional Center (Jail) for the months of January, February, and March, 1982, will be at the rate of seventeen dollars and ninety-four cents (\$17.94) per prisoner day.
