

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held January 20, 1981

PRESENT: President, Holmes R. Shaver  
Commissioner, William C. Parrish  
Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr.

At 10:00 a.m. the Commission met with Sheriff, L. W. Bechtold to discuss cruiser cars for the Wood County Sheriff's Department.

At 9:30 a.m. the Commission met with Maintenance Supervisor, Emmett W. Pickens, and Mr. Larry Hawkins from B.I.E. Combustion Systems. Mr. Hawkins agreed to spend some time with Mr. Pickens to explain about the care and maintenance of the boilers in the court house.

Also, on This, the 20th day of January, 1981 appeared Jerry Russell Layner, in person and with his attorney, William B. Richardson, and also appeared Barbara Lorraine Lammon, a minor, age 15 years, whose birthday is the 28th day of December, 1965. Upon testimony of Jerry Russell Layner and the statement of Barbara Lorraine Lammon that it is her desire to reside with her uncle, Jerry Russell Layner, and wants him to be her guardian. Upon no objection by anyone, the County Commission upon the motion of Commissioner William C. Parrish, seconded by Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. and made unanimous by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver, ORDERED that Jerry Russell Layner be appointed as guardian of Barbara Lorraine Lammon, a minor, and bond shall be set at One Hundred Dollars with Helen Core, (grandmother) as

surety.

At 11:00 a.m. the Commission met with Mrs. Pat Stewart, from the Senior Citizens. Ms. Stewart met with the Commission to explain and review their budgetary system at the center. Mrs. Stewart stated that she felt that there was a misunderstanding about their budget for the Wood County Senior Citizens, and went on to add that monies of which they receive were mandated. Mrs. Stewart also submitted to the Commission their 1981 projected budget. Mrs. Stewart stated that their request from the Commission from Revenue Sharing Entitlement #12, was \$26,000.00. Commissioner President, Holmes R. Shaver, also asked Mrs. Stewart the amount of money that they had requested from the City of Parkersburg and Mrs. Stewart stated that the amount requested was \$15,000.00. The Commission told Mrs. Stewart that they would consider her request with the among the others that have been received.

At 11:25 a.m. the Commission met with Ms. Pat White, and Ms. Connie Mooney representatives from the West Virginia Health Systems Agency. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss regionalization of county health departments. The representatives told the Commission that they were ready for them to make the next move which will be to appoint persons to serve on a task force which will develop a plan for implementation. Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver, stated, "We have our reservations about the program, our pro's and con's." President, Shaver also asked the representatives if all the counties in our region were agreeing to the plan for regionalization. Ms. White - Project Director, stated that they were not. Ms. White went on to say

that they were looking for a minimum of three (3) counties of which must be contiguous, before we can begin implementation. Commission President Shaver, stated that they had asked Wood County Health Department Director, James Sheets for a list of qualified persons of whom he would recommend for a task force, but as of this date they had received no list. Mr. Shaver also added that they can not make a decision in relation to the regionalization until they had received the findings from a task force. Commissioner William C. Parrish, stated that he would like input from qualified individuals as whether or not regionalization would be beneficial from Wood County. Commission President, Shaver stated that they were willing to take a look at the plan.




