We propose to point the stone on the gable above the window arch and to rod anchor it back to the roof steel similar to anchors on other stone window gables. The cost for doing the one gable on the Market Street side toward the river is NINETEEN HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$1925.00) We expect to use the existing scaffolding. If it is not there then scaffolding costs will be added to the cost.
