The following Purchase Orders were received and approved by this Commission:



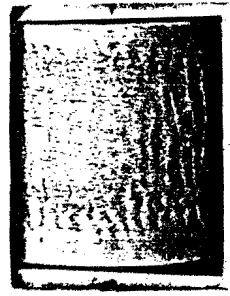

WOOD COUNTY COMMISSION ON CRIME, DELINQUENCY AND CORRECTION

May 27, 1981

The Wood County Commission on Crime, Delinquency and Correction, met in regular session, Wednesday, May 27, 1981, at the City Building, fifth floor. The meeting convened at 12:20, Bill Staats, acting president, presiding. The minutes were read and approved with the following correction: Dick Rogers is in Administration at the Adolescent Mental Health Unit, St. Joseph's Hospital.
