



Upon the motion of Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr.  
seconded by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver, and passed;  
Commissioner William C. Parrish abstained; upon invitation to bid  
for the installation of carpet at the Wood County Correctional  
Center and the West Virginia Cooperative Extension Office and the  
Magistrate's Court, the bid quotation of Model Carpet, 2500 Grand  
Central Avenue, Vienna, WV 26105, was accepted in the Total amount  
of \$6,637.54, which includes the moving of all furnishings and  
will guarantee the carpet upon two (2) years of installation.  
Other bids were received from; Decorating Galleries, Parkersburg,  
WV, which was denied due to the fact that the carpet did not meet  
the specifications and did not include a guarantee installation.  
Also received was a bid from Carpet Corral, 1913 Broadway Avenue,  
Parkersburg, WV 26101, which was also denied due to the fact that  
they did not give a guarantee of installation and left an open end  
labor charge for moving furnishings.

All of which is ordered to be certified to the Auditor of the State and the Sheriff of the County.

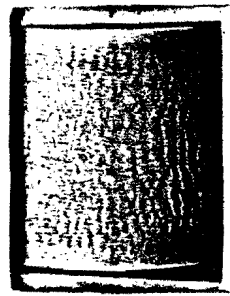




