The County Commission received and approved the proposal from Top Inc., for the renovation of the fountain at the Wood County Court House, in the total amount of \$850.00. It is the understanding of this Commission that Mr. Charles Abdella will handle the project and will check into the water situation to be done on a time and material basis, and will report back to the Commission on Tuesday, June 2nd, 1981.

At 10:00 a.m. the Commission held a hearing for an Alley Closing upon petition. This day came the Plaintiffs by and through their Attorney, George J. Cosenza, to file the Petition to close an unused road or street in Southmoor Addition, Wood County, Parkersburg, West Virginia. Due to the fact that there was no one present with objection to the closing. The County Commission upon the motion of Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. and seconded by President Pro-Tem, William C. Parrish, and passed accepted and approved the closing.

Purchase Order #5024, to Parkersburg Office Supply, in the amount of \$44.86, for the County Clerk's Office.


