IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held October 20, 1981

PRESENT: President, Holmes R. Shaver
Commissioner, William C. Parrish
Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley Jr.

At 9:30 a.m. the Commission held a hearing to appoint a Committee for Mrs. June Gardner the Commission upon hearing the testimony of Mr. Robert Burke (Attorney) counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. David Goldenburg (Attorney) counsel for the Incompetent. Due to the fact that there was no one else present desiring to be appointed as Committee for the said June Gardner the County Commission of Wood County upon the motion of Commissioner William C. Parrish, seconded by Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., and made unanimous by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver unanimously agreed to appoint Mrs. Mamie J. Humphrey as Committee with the stipulation that a \$35,000.00 property bond be posted.

At 10:55 a.m. the Commission met with Mr. Larry Patterson from Cemetary Services and Maintenance. The purpose of Mr. Pattersons meeting with the Commission was to familiarize the Commission with his company and offer his services.

At 11:00 a.m. the Commission met with Mr. Dan Robertson from Time Energy Corporation. Mr. Robertson met with the Commission to discuss and review his company. Commissioner Parrish stated that he should meet with Mr. Dominic Kim, Architect to see what could be done. Also, Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver stated that when the Courthouse was renovated the H.V.A.C. would all be replaced.

The Commission also received various 1981 Personal Property Tax Tickets to be impropered for clerical errors. The Commission received and approved the tickets and forwarded them to the Probate Office to be recorded. Copies are in attachment.




