
The following Purchase Orders were received and approved by this Commission:

Purchase Order No. 5300, to Sherwin-Williams, in the amount of \$26.59, for the Maintenance Department.


Purchase Order No. 5303, to Park Chem, in the amount of \$223.31, for the Correctional Center.


