

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held April 6, 1982

PRESENT: President, Holmes R. Shaver
Commissioner, William C. Parrish
Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr.

At 10:32 a.m. the Commission met with the Cooks at the Wood County Correctional Center, (Mattie M. Byrd & Alice M. Lamm). The purpose of the meeting was to discuss various problems at the Correctional Center (kitchen). This meeting was taped in it's entirety and is filed in the office of the Wood County Administrator, Room 202 of the Wood County Court House.

At 11:30 a.m. the Commission met with Circuit Court Judge Arthur N. Gustke. Judge Gustke told the Commissioners that the Commission on Crime, Delinquency and Corrections could possibly get by with the same budget allocation from the county as they were given last year, even though the allocation for last year was for only nine (9) months. Judge Gustke told the Commission that at least 4.17 hours were spent on Juvenile Hearings in the Court Room, and for every hour in court at least two hours were spent outside the court room. Judge Gustke further noted that for every case that is diverted by preventative programs \$250.00 per case is saved.

Also, Attorney William Pfalzgraf presented to the Commission a proposed agreement between the County and the Wood County Building Commission for the financing of a courthouse judicial annex.

Also, the Commission reviewed petitions seeking a referendum on the Sunday blue law and proposed to make a motion on Thursday to place the issue on the June 1 election ballot.

At 3:00 p.m. the Commission held a Public Hearing for Community Block Grant to be submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development's Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Funds. The state is expected to provide 13 million dollars to be distributed statewide. The first presentation made to the Commission was that of Richard Allen from the Wood County Airport. Mr. Allen requested \$450,000.00 for expansion of the Wood County Court House. The second presentation was from Mr. Bill Leachman Vice-President of the Mountwood Park Board of Directors. Funds requested were in the amount of \$719,122.00 of which would be used to convert the facility at the park and make it a feasible project.

The next presentation was made from Mr. Jim Cox, Manager of the Lubeck Public Service District. Mr. Cox requested the amount of \$491,500.00 to provide a sufficient water system for the residents of Lubeck. Commission President, stated that within the next few weeks the Commission would prioritize the requests and work with the Community Development and Planning Director, Joseph L. Carrico. Commission President Shaver added that they would certainly consider all of the requests and they would be reviewed.

The Commission also received various 1982 Personal Property Tax Tickets to be impropered for clerical errors. The Commission received and approved the tickets and forwarded them to the Probate Office to be recorded. Copies are in attachment.

Also, upon the motion of Commission President, Holme R. Shaver, seconded by Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., and made

unanimous by Commissioner William C. Parrish that the Wood County Court House will be closed on Friday, April 9th in observance of Good Friday.






