At 9:00 a.m. the Commission met with Mr. Robert Scalf from the City of Parkersburg and Mr. Terry Tamburini from the M.O.V.R.C. (Mid-Ohio Valley Regional Council). The topics under discussion were the parks in the City/County. Mr. Scalf also pointed out that he would like to see access provided to all City/County Parks to provide recreation. This meeting was taped in it's entirety and is filed in the office of the County Administrator.

Also, the Commission met with members of the Wood County Deputy Sheriff's Association to discuss the fleet cruiser car plan for Wood County. Commissioner Parrish stated that if it could be proven that the County would save money he would be in favor of the fleet program. Commissioner Parrish, went on to state that they would have the County Administrator, Sibyl Rowan search out the plan and report back to them (Commission), and they would be back in touch with the deputies to report the findings.

Purchase Order #6000-8, to Mico-Bermans, in the amount of \$46.32, for the Planning Commission.






