IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held August 31, 1982

On this the 31st day of August, 1982 the Commission the swearing in of Mrs. Ruth Nonamaker as a Deputy Assessor, in and for the Wood County Assessor's Office.

Also, this day the Wood County Commission by it's President Pro-Tem, William C. Parrish and the National Association of Counties entered into an Administrative Service Agreement in relation to the Deferred Compensation Program that the County agreed to participate in by Order of record entered on the 15th day of July, 1982. A copy is in attachment.

Also, the Commission received various quotations for temporary electrical connections for heating units for the Wood County Court House in relation to the installation to the H.V.A.C. (Heating, Ventilation and Air-Conditioning) System presently being installed in the Wood County Court House. The Commission upon the motion of Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., seconded by Commissioner William C. Parrish and passed accepted and approved the quotation of Blair Electrical Contractors, Inc., in the amount of \$1,030.00. Also, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously passed it was ORDERED that the Wood County Commission purchase three (3) 1981 Ford L.T.D.'s under the option to purchase Agree-

ment which was entered into with Dils Motor Co., on the 11th day of August, 1982 and appearing of record in Court Order Book #44, Page 158. A copy of this ORDER is in attachment.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., seconded by President Pro-Tem, William C. Parrish and passed, it was ORDERED that the bid to install a complete sprinkler system in the Wood County Court House be awarded to Brewer & Company, of Charleston, West Virginia, in the amount of \$61,674.00 contingent upon a letter being received from them stating that they will do the work after regular working hours, for the additional amount of \$3,645.00 and they will comply with the Davis Bacon Act and will provide a 100% Performance Bond. 
