

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held February 23, 1982

PRESENT: President, Holmes R. Shaver  
Commissioner, William C. Parrish  
Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley Jr.

Upon advertisement to bid for carpet for the Wood County Magistrates Court Building, the County Commission of Wood County upon the motion of Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley Jr., seconded by President, Holmes R. Shaver and passed the Commission accepted and approved the bid of Carpet Corral, in the amount of \$1,650.00 for carpet for the Magistrates Building. The low bid from Mark-Christopher Inc., was disqualified due to the fact that it did not meet with the bid specifications. Commissioner Parrish abstained. A copy of this ORDER is in attachment.

At 9:30 a.m. the Commission witnessed the swearing in of Mr. Lee Johnson as a member of the Lubeck Public Service District Board.

Also, upon advertisement to bid for Personal Property and Real Estate Tax Tickets the following bids and quotations were received; Burroughs Corp., 1318 - 12th Street, Parkersburg, WV 26101, in the total amount of \$\$3,898.85, Moore Business Forms, P.O. Box 634, Parkersburg, WV 26101, in the total amount of \$4478.95, Parkersburg Printing Co., Inc., 519 - 4th Street, Parkersburg, WV 26101, in the total amount of \$6,125.00. Upon the motion of Commissioner William C. Parrish, seconded by Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley Jr., and made unanimous by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver it was ORDERED that the aforementioned bids and quotations be held over for further discussion and review with disposition to be made at a later session of this Commission.

Also, the Commission met with Mrs. Dorothy Muse, Director of the Parkersburg-Wood County Public Library. The purpose of the meeting with the Commission was to request \$90,500.00 from the Commission for the library. Mrs. Muse stated that they needed to maintain the base they presently had and if not they would loose their status as a Library Service Center. Mrs. Muse stated that they were requesting the same amount as last year, but they could certainly use any additional monies that the Commission might see fit. Commissioner

Parrish told Mrs. Muse and the various other Board members who were present that he felt sure that it would be no problem to meet the request of which was the same as last year, but it would be very difficult to give an increase.

At 3:45 p.m. the Commission met with Mr. Kim Marshall and two (2) other representatives from the Deerwalk Volunteer Fire Department. The purpose of the meeting was to request that the Commission give their Department consideration for the Community Development Block Grant monies. Mr. Marshall stated that the money would be used to build and construct an additional meeting room to the Fire Station. Mr. Marshall also noted that the room could be used in voting as a Precinct. Mr. Marshall went on to explain that the addition would be helpful to the handicapped in voting. The Commission told Mr. Marshall that they would certainly give their request consideration. The amount requested from the Grant was \$30,000.00.

Also, on this the 23rd day of February, 1982 the County Commission of Wood County upon the motion of Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley Jr., seconded by Commissioner William C. Parrish and made unanimous by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver unanimously agreed to inlist in the services of William R. Pfalzgraf, Attorney, to aide and assist the Wood County Commission to finance and construct a Wood County Judicial Annex. If the said Wood County Judicial Annex is completed, as agreed, the said William R. Pfalzgraf will justify an hourly charge for work done, if not completed, there will be no charge for his services.
