

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held June 8, 1982

PRESENT: President, Holmes R. Shaver
Commissioner, William C. Parrish
Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr.

The Commission met as a Board of Canvassers to canvass the June 1, 1982 Primary Election.

Also, the Commission met with Mayor, Pat Pappas and various other members of City Council as well as Mr. George Fox, Director, of the Wood County Emergency Services. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss a proposed E.O.C. (Emergency Operations Center). The possibility of the E.O.C. being placed in the Court House Annex were discussed. The total amount for the project would be \$360,000.00 of which \$180,000.00 would be provided for from F.E.M.A. (Federal Emergency Management Association) \$90,000.00 would come from the County. The Commission requested that the City share the cost. The City's share would also be in the amount of \$90,000.00. Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver urged that the City Council consider their request. Mayor Pappas, pointed out in the meeting that the City would be needing to hire more police officers and also firemen, therefore, money would be hard to find. The Council agreed to discuss the matter further at the next City Council meeting and would keep in touch with the Commission as to their findings.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., seconded by Commissioner William C. Parrish, and made unanimous by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver, due to inadequate

storage by virtue of the State Code of West Virginia the County Commission of Wood County has engaged the services of Mr. Clair A. Snyder to aide in the safe keeping of records of County Elected Officials during working hours, and located at 407 & 409 Market Street (Storage Building for County Records.)

Said employment shall be for a thirty (30) day period. To become effective June 8, 1982, at the rate of \$500.00 per month. A copy of this ORDER is in attachment.







Said employment shall be for a thirty (30) day period. To become effective June 8, 1982 at the rate of \$500.00 per month.






