

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held June 22, 1982

PRESENT: President, Holmes R. Shaver  
Commissioner, William C. Parrish  
Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr.

At 9:30 a.m. the Commission met with Assessor, Eugene A. Knotts, and Deputy Assessor, Robert K. Mason. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss various problems in regard to the Assessor's budget.

Also, at 1:30 p.m. the Commission witnessed a hearing alledging the competency of Jean Ellen Burgess. The Commission upon hearing the testimonies of various witnesses and upon receipt of a written statement from the alleged incompetent's doctor. The Commission ORDERED that the said Jean Ellen Burgess be declared Incompetent. Upon unanimous decision of the Commission the Commission accepted the Petition of the Incompetents husband (Earl L. Burgess) to act as Committee for his wife.

Also, at 2:30 p.m. the Commission witnessed a hearing alledging the competency of Lucy R. Bueter. The Commission upon hearing the testimonies of various witnesses and upon receipt of a written statement from the alleged incompetent's doctor. The Commission ORDERED that the said Lucy R. Bueter be declared Incompetent. Upon unanimous decision of the Commission the Commission accepted the Petition of the Incompetent's brother-in-law, Harry A. Bradley to act as Committee for said Lucy R. Bueter.

The Commission also received two (2) Erroneous Assessments to be impropered for clerical errors. The Commission received and approved the Assessments and forwarded them to the

Probate Office to be recorded. Copies are in attachment.

Purchase Order #6145, to C.W.S., in the amount of \$34.65, for the Circuit Clerk's Office.


