IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held October 19, 1982

On this the 19th day of October, 1982 the County Commission of Wood County upon advertisement to bid for Property, General Liability & Fleet Insurance Coverage, received the following bids and quotations; Waters Insurance Agency, w/\$500.00 deductible\$1,769.00 and w/\$100.00 deductible..\$1,178.00, and McDonough Caperton, in the amount of \$27,940.00, and Regal & Padden, Inc., in the amount of \$24,338.00 and Bill Bailey Insurance Agency, in the amount of \$27,543.00. Upon the motion of President Pro-Tem, William C. Parrish, seconded by Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley Jr., and passed, it is hereby ORDERED that the aforementioned bids and quotations be held over for further discussion and review with disposition to be made at a later session of this Commission.

At 10:30 a.m. the Commission met with Mr. Frank Cain, from Uwanta Linen to discuss the need for more uniforms for the prisoners. Mr. Cain pointed out to the Commission that they needed a larger inventory, and that there should be at least three (3) uniforms per prisoner. The Commission also suggested the possibility of purchasing the uniforms that they were presently using and then rent more. Mr. Cain told the Commission that it would cost \$3.98 per uniform to purchase them and then void the contract. Mr. Cain went on to say that they could launder the sheets and pillow cases for the jail also. The Commission requested that Mr. Cain figure out quotation and get back with them by Thursday.
